Application Process:

1. Complete the Jerusalem application online at [MySEU application](#).
2. Pay the \$300 deposit for Jerusalem semester: with credit card online, with cash to the cashier in the Business Office, or by transfer of excess funds on student account [see Student Financial Services].
3. Complete all financial arrangements for the total cost of the Jerusalem semester by consulting with Student Financial Services. When your financial plan is approved, Ms. Joyce LeMasters will email notification to Mr. Cedrick Valrie, and you will receive a copy. All previously arranged financial aid, including loans and scholarships, will be applicable just as if you were on campus.
4. Deliver a copy of your passport to Cedrick, Director of Jerusalem Studies, located in the Spence Lobby, Room 1. Please note your passport expiration date must be at least six months beyond your travel dates. If you do not have a passport, information is available on MySEU under Academics/Jerusalem Semester. Contact Cedrick (cdvalrie@seu.edu or 863.667.5417) for additional assistance.
5. Complete and return the Health Form that is on MySEU to Cedrick.
6. Upon acceptance into the program, you will be registered automatically for the three Jerusalem courses listed on MySEU. You must consult your academic advisor to update your Four-Year Degree Plan and select two additional online or evening classes. To register for these, you MUST complete the Online/Evening Registration Form and submit it to Ms. Linda Kelso in the Office of the Registrar.
